



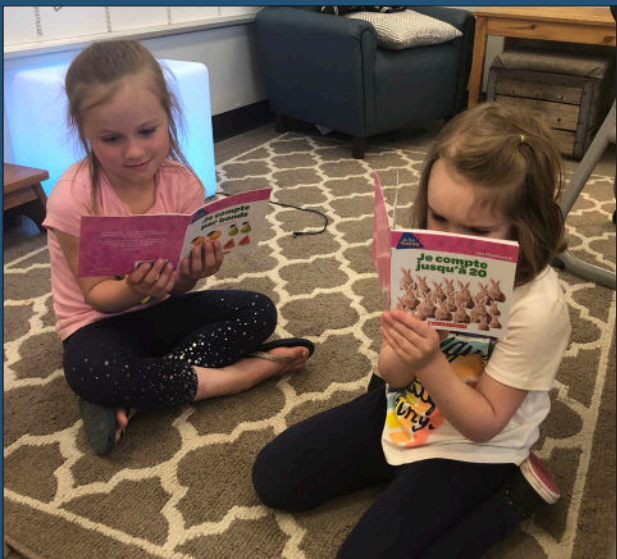

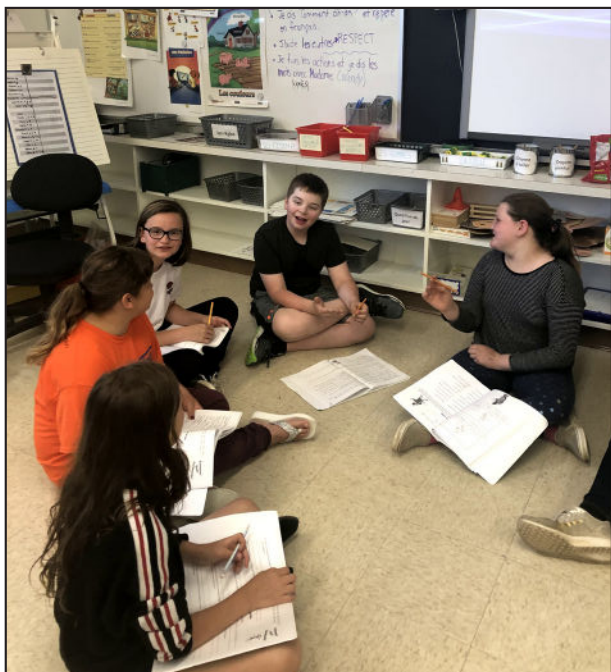

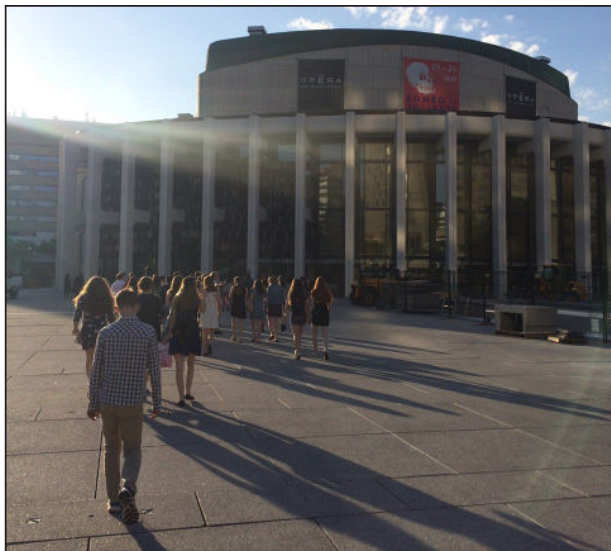
Extended FSL from Kindergarten to Grade 3 is offered at:
